Mid-Shore Community Foundation, in partnership with the QAC Chamber of Commerce and QAC Local Management Board, is hosting a Nonprofit Leadership Program for nonprofit staff, board members and volunteers in Queen Anne's County. Led by award-winning nonprofit leader Rob Levit, Licensed Consultant with the Standards for Excellence® Institute, the 4-Session Program will provide an interactive, accessible and in-depth look at the essential pillars of operating an excellent nonprofit organization. Participants are expected to attend all four sessions.

SESSION #1: Fundraising from Mission

An organization's mission, ability to demonstrate its results and share compelling stories with donors and stakeholders are the best pathway to long-term financial sustainability. Learn the elements of fundraising from mission and apply them to your organization.

SESSION #2: Program Design, Delivery and Evaluation

What makes a great program? How does an organization sustain long-term delivery and performance of key programs? How do nonprofits demonstrate success to funders and stakeholders? Learn the answers to these questions and more while creating an individualized plan for your nonprofit organization.

SESSION #3: Strategic Thinking and Planning

Many nonprofit organizations view strategic planning as a laborious and often expensive chore that needs to be done every few years. In this workshop, learn how an invigorating and collaborative process for strategic planning can be a pathway to innovation and organizational renewal. Leave with the outlines of a strategic plan.

SESSION #4: Graduation and all about Boards – Engagement, Roles and Staff Interaction

On this final day of the series, participants who have attended all four sessions will receive a certificate of completion for their resume and portfolio. In addition, the content will explore the roles and responsibilities of board of directors, how boards interact with staff and the pitfalls that boards can experience when they are not fully engaged with the mission and programs of the organizations they serve.
