The Character Counts! Advisory Council is pleased to announce that applications are now being accepted for the 2021 Faye Lister Teen of Character Scholarship. This \$500 scholarship, made possible through the Centreville Rotary, is available to any high school senior who resides in Queen Anne’s County and exemplifies the Six Pillars of Character – *Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, & Citizenship*.

Anyone may nominate a student for this scholarship, including the students themselves. Nominations may be made by a community member including teachers, parents, employers, club moderators, neighbors or anyone wishing to recognize a special High School Senior residing in Queen Anne’s County. Nominating is a quick process including a brief application and a Nomination Letter of 350 words or less describing how a student’s actions exemplify the Six Pillars of Character. Nominees must be candidates planning on attending a College or Trade School.
